Lot 1032: 300€ → 540€ (+23%)

1919, ANVERSVILLE (2), Belgian Congo, envelope, written on board of the ship, franked with (1x) 5c and (2x) 10c Belgian stamps, cancelled by "ANVERSVILLE PAQUEBOT" cachet (24mm with star in the middle) in black, with straight-lined mark "COURRIER DE HAUTE MER" in black (scarce mark), sent to Namur / Belgium where it arrived March 22, 1919, with handwritten note "T 040" due to the out of use (since Oct. 15, 1915) of the (2x) 10c red, taxed at 40c, paid with (2x) 20c violet overprinted "T", this letter proves that the ship "Anversville" had returned from exile, forced by the First World War, probably as early as 21 March 1919, Ex Claude Delbeke, one of the gem of his collection, great rarity

1899, BRUXELLESVILLE (1), Belgian Congo, picture postcard (view of the ship), written during the stopover in Flessingue, franked with (1x) 1 penny and sent from Dovers Nov. 2, 1899 to Anvers / Belgium where it arrived Nov. 3, (movement of the ship "Bruxellesville (1)" Anvers Nov. 1, 1899 and Matadi Nov. 25, 1899), very fine and very scarce

BRUXELLESVILLE (2), Belgian Congo, picture postcard (view of Freetown / Sierra Leone), written on board during the stopover in Sierra Leone, franked with (1x) 1d Sierra Leone stamp, cancelled by the straight-lined mark "PAQUEBOT" applied at Anvers / Belgium, with straight-lined marks "BRUXELLESVILLE" in black (51mm) and "LE COMMISSAIRE DU BORD" in black (48mm), superb and scarce

1926, Ruanda Urundi, envelope franked with (vertical pair) of 50c on 25c blue - EAAOB Mols Malines issue, posted on board of the ship "Baron Dhanis" on the Tanganyika lake, stamps cancelled "FLOTILLE LAC - 26 JANV 1926 - Bon DHANIS" in black (Herreweghe type BN/II) and sent to Belgium, few items known posted on board of C.F.L. ships, some damages but a masterpiece of the Belgian Congo, ex Lindekens Ph. collection, definitively a gem

1906, Congo Free State, envelope, franked with (1x) 5c green (plate I2+B2) and (1x) 10c carmine - Mols 1900 issue, sent from Thysville Nov. 7, 1906 to Boma where it arrived Nov. 9, 1906, rate of April 1, 1896 for domestic cover 15c/15gr, correctly franked, master piece of Congo Free State, reverse flap roughly open, otherwise superb

1924, Belgian Congo, "CONGO BELGE - KUESI - SERVICE DES POSTES" (administrative cachet) cachet in violet tied the (5x) 5c and (1x) 50c - Vloors issue, on envelope sent to Cambridge / USA, via Fort Portal / Uganda Oct. 2, 1924, rate of May 1, 1924 for international cover 75c for first 20gr, correctly franked, a very scarce administrative cachet used as cancellator cachet, probably unique, definitively very impressive and a master piece, very fine

1916, Ruanda Urundi, postage free envelope, written by a soldier "Mr... sous officier - Force Publique du Congo Belge à Kigali - via Marseille, Mombasa et Kabale" (Mr... non-commissioned officer - Belgian Congo Public Force in Kigali - via Marseille, Mombasa and Kabale), to Baarle-Hertog / Belgium where it arrived in August 1916, via Mbarara (June 7), Entebbe (June 12), Mombasa (June 19 and 20) and Paris Etranger, with handwritten censor on reverse side "Censuré" + sign, with censor mark "C.F." applied at Folkestone, superb cover of the offensive period to Tabora, very scarce

1962, Katanga, "FORCES KATANGAISES - Dét DILOLO", domestic envelope, sent in postage free by a soldier of the Katanga army from Dilolo-C November 13 1962 to the secretary of the primary school in Sola (via Kongolo in November), with circular "two rifles" cachet "FORCES KATANGAISES - Dét DILOLO" in violet, with straight-lined mark "Expéditeur Inconnu / Rebutis Provinciaux" and "RETOUR A L'ENVOYEUR", very few known covers, small damage at the bottom, very impressive, great rarity of the Katanga, Ex collection Babicki, with BCSC certificate

1960, Katanga, LUBUDI-A (Heim & Keach type 10(A)-) cachet tied August 2, 1960 the Republic of Congo stamps (1x) 5fr - Independence issue, (1x) 6,50fr - Flowers with overprint "CONGO" issue and (1x) 1fr - Animals with overprint "CONGO" issue (damaged), registered envelope, sent to Gand / Belgium, rate of June 30, 1960 for airmail cover to Belgium 6,50fr for first 10gr + registration 6fr = 12,50fr, correctly franked, with contents in Flemish (about events, Belgians going to Lobito to take a Belgian boat), amazing, cover with scarce cancellation, franking and historical text

1836, Maroc Français, précurseur, LAC datée "Tangeri il 6 Aprile 1836 (Tanger le 6 avril 1836) et destinée à un frères à Salmes / Piemont / Italie où elle parvint le 20/4, dans le texte de la lettre "je profite d'un vapeur français qui va bientôt partir pour Toulon", entrée dans le système postal à "Toulon-sur-Mer (78) le 15/4/1836, avec marque d'entrée encadrée avec partie inférieure grattée "PAYS D'OUTREMER", marque de purification du Lazaret, en italique (rouge de 1833 à 1837, noire en 1838, dans un ovale à partir de 1839) "Purifié à Toulon" et 2 incisions verticales, griffe "T.F" (= Transit Français), indication de la taxe "14" dont 1 décime pour voie de mer, très beau et extrêmement rare

1911, Maroc Espagnol, enveloppe, affranchie avec (1x) 10c rouge (Y&T 4), expédiée de Mogador le 9/5/1911 vers Ceuta où elle parvint en mai 1911, cachets de transits par les bureaux espagnoles de Saffi 9/5, Mazagan 11/5, Tanger 13/5 et Algesiras 13/5, enveloppe réparée et ouverte pour exposition, voyage intérieur impressionnant via les bureaux espagnols au Maroc et via l'Espagne
