August 31, 1961, South Kasai State, envelope, franked with (1x) 1fr - Leopard in a "V" definitive issue in combination with Belgian Congo stamp (1x) 6,50fr - 5 Kings issue, sent from Gandajika -B August 31, 1961 to Chicago / USA, GANDAJIKA-B cachet (type Heim & Keach 10(B)-) in black, very fine and rare cover showing the combination with South Kasai stamp and Belgian Congo stamp (very scarce), very impressive, with Lindekens certificate 31 août 1961, Etat du Sud Kasai, enveloppe affranchie avec (1x) 1fr - Léopard dans un « V » (émission définitive) combiné avec un timbre du Congo belge (1x) 6,50fr - Émission des 5 Rois, expédiée de Gandajika-B le 31 août 1961 à destination de Chicago / USA, cachet GANDAJIKA-B (type Heim & Keach 10(B)-) en noir, très bel et rare pli présentant la combinaison d'un timbre du Sud Kasai et d'un timbre du Congo belge (très rare), très impressionnant, avec certificat Lindekens

1895, Denmark, envelope, franked with (2x) 20c blue (Y&T 37), sent from Vallo July 16, 1895 to "Mr. Le Baron de Salmuth Sous Lieutenant de la Force Publique - zone Arabe - Congo Afrique" (=Mr. Le Baron de Salmuth Second Lieutenant of the Public Force - Arab Zone - Congo Africa) / Congo Free State, via Lisboa / Portugal (July 22), Banana (August 13), Boma and Leopoldville (September 4), with Congolese handwritten note "Décédé" (passed away) in blue pen, boxed mark "DECEDE" in blue and handwritten note "5 août 1895" + signatures (double confirmation) in red, "REBUT" mark in blue and returned to sender, it arrived in Vallo November 29, via Kjobenhavn (Nov. 29), a superb cover written during the Arab campaign, which ended with the capture of Redjaf in Lado in 1897, this is an exceptional historical document, one of the earliest known examples of the framed 'DECEDE' mark, a master piece of Congo. (Baron) SALMUTH (de). Officer in the Force Publique (Ballenstadt, Duchy of Anhalt, Germany, 10 February 1868 – Micici, Ponthierville, 5 August 1895). He studied law and political science at the University of Leipzig from 1888 until early 1890, enlisting in May of that year in the 8th Royal Saxon Infantry Regiment. He was promoted to second lieutenant in December and resigned his commission on 15 July 1892 to settle in Belgium, where he had many friends and acquaintances. After spending a year and a half working for the V. Mabilie company in Mariemont, he applied in 1894 for a position with the Congo Free State. On the recommendation of General de Villiers, aide-de-camp of the King Leopold II, he was accepted as a second lieutenant in the Public Force and embarked at Antwerp aboard of the s/s Coomassie on 6 April 1894. Assigned to the Arab zone upon his arrival in the Congo in early May, he left Boma on the 10th of that month and reached Wabundu on 19 July. From there, he was sent to the Nyangwe region, which had just been cleared of Arab traffickers by Dhanis, Ponthier, Lothaire and Henry, and was given command of the Micici post. It was there that he succumbed to haemorrhagic fever on 5 August 1895

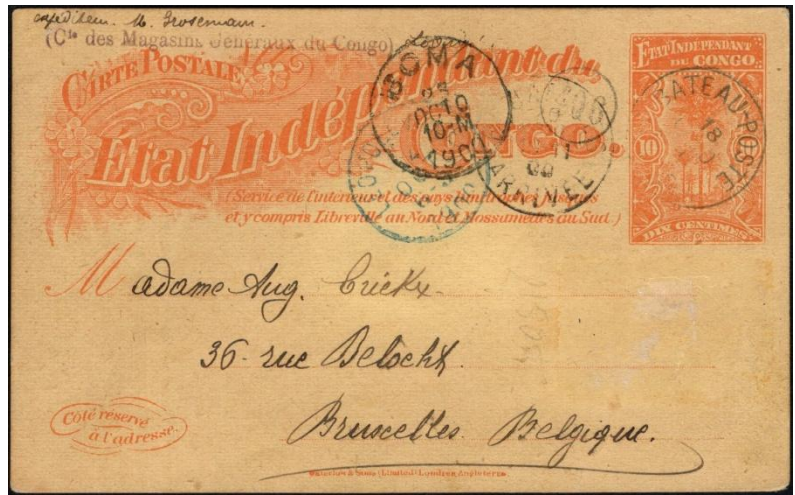

1906, Congo Free State, picture postcard (view of Nairobi station), franked with (1x) 10c carmine - Mols 1900 issue, written in Muvumbano / Lake Kivu / German East Africa August 15, 1906, carried by native runner and posted across the border in Congo Free State at Uvira Sept. 4, 1906 and sent to Aywaille / Belgium where it arrived in December 1906, via Stanleyville (Oct. 10) and Leopoldville (Oct. 30), this postcard was written by Joseph Héron who was a second lieutenant in the Force Publique and arrived in Boma on 17 June 1905. "He was appointed to the post of Luvungi on 14 October 1905, where he was chosen to take part in the geographical mission that travelled through the region (Lake Kivu) from 27 July 1906 to the end of September 1906.", a piece of history and very scarce for cross border mail.

1900, Congo Free State, postal stationery catalogue Stibbe #14 (one stamp at 5c missing), cancelled "BATEAU POSTE N° ?" probably 2 (number and date impossible to read but with angular measurement = Bateau Poste n°2 - identified as mailboat "Ville d'Anvers"), sent to Bruxelles / Belgium where it arrived November 20, 1900, via Leopoldville (Oct. 24) and Boma (Oct. 28), scarce Bateau Poste cancellator, very scarce on item, with Vander Marcken certificate

1917, incoming mail to Belgian troops in the field in German East African Operation (Ruanda Urundi), Belgian Congo postal stationery Stibbe #47 reply part, at 10c red on blue uprated with (1x) Belgian stamp at 5c, sent from La Panne / Belgium (unoccupied territory) October 19, 1917 to a nursing non-commissioned officer in Kigoma where it arrived January 9, 1918, an exceptional item combining several rarities (postal stationery foreign reply, from Belgian unoccupied territory, rare postal stationery), amazing, some toning, but masterpiece
